

Case study #2 – media organization lobby, United States

Faced with a significant rise in threats, this media organization looked to harden the glass entranceway into their building.

The glass wall featured in the accompanying image was a recent build but was not designed with ballistic capabilities. The cost to remove the glass wall and replace it with a ballistic-hardened glass wall was estimated at \$350,000 - \$400,000.

Using ACE 300 Series security laminates, the existing wall was retrofitted in place to a ballistic rating of UL Level 2 (357 magnum).
